4 CARBER CLUSTERS

Architecture & Construction

Programs in this cluster prepare students for careers in designing, planning, managing, building, and maintaining the built environment.





Business Management & Administration

Programs in this cluster prepare students for careers in planning, organizing, directing, and evaluating business functions essential to efficient and productive business operations.

Manufacturing

Programs in this cluster prepare students to plan, manage, and perform the processing of materials into intermediate or final products, and the related professional and technical support activities such as production planning and control, maintenance, and manufacturing/process engineering.





Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics

Programs in this cluster prepare students to plan, manage, and provide scientific research and professional and technical services (e.g., physical science, social science, engineering) and include laboratory and testing services, and research and development services.
